Repeated exposure to dust from this product can cause dermatitis, keratitis, and/or respiratory allergic effects. In addition, repeated exposure to pentachlorophenol treated wood dust may cause potential toxic effects from the absorption of pentachlorophenol.

- Avoid unprotected contact with treated wood.
- Sweep or vacuum dust for recovery or disposal.
- Avoid prolonged or repeated inhalation of wood dust.
- Avoid contact of wood dust with eyes and skin.

FIRST AID: If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air. In case of contact with eyes or skin, flush with large amounts of water. If irritation or symptoms persist, contact a Physician.
